A message from our Executive Director

SON Ministries recognizes that children do well when their families do well and families do best when they live in a supportive community.

This year we partnered with families as one started a business, as moms found employment, and as children blossomed in our safe loving environments! This has been a year of tremendous growth both with numbers of families served and staff needed to sustain programming as the services we offered move forward. *We trust God to lead us Serving Our Neighbors.* Many, in this community and beyond are asking us to consult and teach specifically HOW we run our ministries. We know this is the direction God is taking us: to grow our Hilliard based ministry in both numbers and quality while simultaneously documenting what we do and HOW we do it.

Our unique SON values drive and guide us:

- PEOPLE are our priority RELATIONSHIPS are our goal.
- We see the DIVINE in each person: each has a *purpose* and a *voice*.
- We build up **COMMUNITY** one *respectful, empowering relationship* at a time.
- We bring **HOPE** to children and families in need by connecting them to people, resources and a hand up.
- We nurture **DREAMS** to *alleviate poverty*.
- Through PARTNERSHIPS, we strive together for the best for our community.
- We are INSPIRED by the unexpected . . . Join us!

In 2005, suburban poverty outgrew urban poverty for the first time in the U.S. We have seen the number of children receiving a free or reduced price school lunch in the Hilliard School District increase by 72% from 2,158 in 2006 to 3,714 in 2013. The challenges of suburban poverty are unique. People are disconnected from resources and transportation. Poverty is less concentrated causing isolation. Therefore poverty goes unseen. SON Ministries grew from one ministry, the Hilliard Free Summer Lunch program in 2007, to a faith-based not for profit in 2009 partnering with and connecting families facing poverty to resources year-round.

This year our Family ESOL/Kids Club program exploded into five large program areas under one program umbrella: Early Childhood (where we have added Early Literacy components), Kids Club Recess, Kids Club Academic Support, Hospitality/Connecting Families to Resources, Job Readiness/ Connecting Adults to Job Opportunities. We have also begun training the community's teens to connect in a meaningful way through community service.

We LOVE God by Serving Our Neighbors which fills the hopeless with hope, reconnects the marginalized with our community, and inspires others to join the mission! We feel blessed to serve in this vibrant community which is filled with citizens and leaders who care deeply about their neighbors. Start with us; grow with us; OWN with us! We look forward to incubating more DREAMS in the coming year as we build community, work to alleviate poverty, and strive *together* for the BEST for our children and families, and our community.

Hilliard Free Lunch Summer Camp for Kids (since 2007)

SON Ministries provides a free nutritious breakfast and lunch to children facing poverty ages 1-18 for 45 days of the summer. Hours of fun and educational programming are offered daily around lunch.

Family ESOL/Kids Club (since 2008)

ESOL = English for Speakers of Other Languages

SON Ministries provides academic support, recreation and a healthy snack for children facing poverty in the Hilliard area (from 20 Franklin County zip codes), while their parents attend English classes. Families represent 45 different countries of origin. The program meets two evenings a week during the school year for a total of six hours a week. New in 2013: introduction of early literacy elements for the preschool-aged children in this program as well as Job Readiness preparation for adult students.

Connecting Families to Resources

SON Ministries assists families facing the unique challenges of suburban poverty to address basic needs (physical, spiritual, educational, and social). We connect families to SON Ministries' programs and to other community resources through the website SON Ministries founded and continues to coordinate, Hilliard Helps, www.HilliardHelps.org. The website lists programs that connect families in need in the Hilliard School District. We collaborate with community members, businesses, churches, civic/social organizations, and schools to offer families a hand up out of poverty. We partner with an adult ESOL class and the Columbus Bar Association to offer a monthly Free Legal Clinic.

Community Education

SON Ministries offers education through training/speeches around these topics:


- The unique challenges of suburban poverty.

SON Ministries Community Impact 44,960 > Served 8,027 lunches to children through our Hilliard Free Lunch Summer Camp for Kids, bringing our seven-year total to 44,960 free lunches served. Served 2,081 breakfasts to children in need during the summer of 2013. Seven-Year Total Free **Lunches Served** > Provided **bussing for 119 children** to attend the Lunch program. Sponsored 4 lunch sites, with SON Ministries administering activity programs at three sites. Hired and managed 15 summer staff: 3 Site Leaders, 6 Assistant Site Leaders, 4 AmeriCorps Vista Site Staff, 1 Monitor, 1 Columbus Foundation Fellow.
